Subject: Banners Across State Highways Policy

Policy for Banners Across State Highways

Banners will be allowed above and across State Highways only if the following criteria are met by the proposer:

- 1. The State of Rhode Island must be indemnified with a minimum 2 million dollar per occurrence liability insurance policy naming the Department of Transportation as an additional insured.
- 2. A police detail for traffic control must be provided when necessary.
- 3. Permission from the utility companies to use poles must be provided when necessary.
- 4. No commercial advertising will be allowed.
- 5. Approval of the RIDOT Design Section when deemed necessary.
- 6. A Letter of Authorization must be obtained before any banner is erected.

• **State Highways:** Means all State controlled Roads, expect for Interstates and limited access freeways.
